**Job Title:**

Production Quality Engineer

**Job Overview:**

**Job Duties:**

The role will evolve over time but at its' core will involve:

- Provide Quality Assurance leadership to further enhance Irish Pressings' globally recognised reputation as a reliable and quality assured supplier;
- Responsibility as the central point of contact for all Quality matters with customers and suppliers;
- Ensure early and professional engagement with customers on Quality requirements;
- Day-to-day management of Quality Control operations and staff;
- Evaluating, identifying and implementing an optimal Quality Control structure to meet the requirements of our customers;
- Managing Product Quality to meet agreed project spec requirements (for sample parts, prototypes parts, serial production parts, etc.);
- Responsibility for coordinating and managing a review team for the approval of all Gauges and Fixtures used internally;
- Evaluating and implementing process improvements where identified as relevant;
- Managing the relationship and communication between Quality team, Production team and the Toolroom;
- Organising relevant Quality Team meetings to drive the Quality agenda;
- Drive changes and improvements in the Quality Assurance and control systems;
- Manage and develop the Quality team members through mentoring, motivating and delegating tasks appropriately;
- To have a clear understanding of each customer assessment criteria in order to be able to propose improvement strategies;
- Review, develop and implement appropriate KPIs for Quality function;
- Report to Senior Management on a weekly basis.

- Third level Qualification in Quality Management or other relevant discipline;
- Previous experience working in ISO 9001, ISO TS16949, VDA coupled with strong background in the Automotive Industry;
- Experience managing a Quality team;
- Excellent communication skillset;
