Job Overview:

Job Duties:

The role will evolve over time but at its' core will involve:

- Supporting the day-to-day management of the Irish Pressings Quality system.
- Act as SME on all documentation management queries related to the Quality Management System.
- Manage the scheduling and completion of internal audits of the Irish Pressings Quality System
- Support and develop robust training processes to ensure Quality requirements are effectively deployed within the business.
- Take a lead on evaluating and implementing process improvements within the QMS as they are identified.
- Work with process owners within the business to ensure that quality processes are clearly documented within respective areas and support Continuous Improvements efforts as they are identified.
- Oversee and manage the change control processes within the QMS ensuring all changes are tracked and implemented. Complete training within the business on change control processes as required to ensure the processes are operating effectively.
- Review, develop and implement appropriate KPIs for the Quality function to communicate process performance.
