Process Improvements Engineer

Job Overview:

As Irish Pressings continues to grow at pace, the organisation structure needs to evolve similarly. *Process Improvement* is an area that the Company wishes to focus on and invest in with the aim of developing and shaping the future direction of manufacturing within the company.

Job Duties & Responsibilities:

The role will evolve over time but at its' core will involve:

- Analysis of existing processes and development of innovative and efficient improvement processes across all aspects of operations – particularly production processes;
- Introduce and implement process improvements that serve to increase operational efficiency and output whilst ensuring the highest level of Quality, Health & Safety standards are maintained;
- Regular presentation of information to Line Management detailing areas where process deficiencies have been identified and outlining the proposed process improvements to resolve the issues identified and increase output and efficiencies;
- Collection and maintenance of detailed, valid and accurate data on operational performance to ensure that all process improvements proposed are being driven by accurate data;
- Working closely with Production, Quality and Engineering Departments to identify, prioritise and analyse areas of continuous improvement across the core operational areas;
- Collaborate with Robotics & Automation Team to ensure that all feasible automation solutions are being appropriately considered with long-term efficiencies and solutions being prioritised;
- Project Management of process improvement projects to ensure that improvements are being planned and executed on-time, to the required standard and within budget;
- Help to instil an ethos of continuous process improvements within the Organisation so that a culture of identifying efficiency projects and initiatives become a core competency within all Departments;

Candidate qualifications:

- 3rd level Qualification in Mechanical Engineering, Automation or related Engineering Discipline;
- Minimum of 3 years' experience in Process Engineering or Process Improvement role;
- Demonstratable experience in Project Management preferred;
- Experience working in the automotive industry advantageous but not essential;
- Excellent communication skills are critical;
- Highly-motivated, proactive, enthusiastic and organised individual capable of working both on own initiative and as a team player;
- Strong analytical skills and attention to detail
